The Order of Nunavik is conferred upon Inuit men and women “for outstanding achievements in different fields.”

The Order of Nunavik Program celebrates the accomplishments of Nunavik Inuit of all ages and inspires Nunavik beneficiaries to strive to reach its goals.

Each year, Nunavik Inuit are nominated by their fellow JBNQA beneficiaries for their achievements, leadership, and innovation.

The final four selected, accomplished and motivated Inuit are named Nunavik Role Models and inducted into the Order of Nunavik at an award ceremony held during the Makivik Corporation Annual General meeting.

The Nunavik Role Model Program aims to:

- Promote healthy lifestyles and self-esteem among Nunavik Inuit.
- Strengthen Nunavik culture and identity.
- Promote positive public images of Nunavik Inuit.
- Facilitate the availability of Nunavik Role Models to Nunavik Inuit and communities.
- Influence behaviors and attitudes of Nunavik Inuit toward healthy lifestyles.
- Foster inspired leadership.

1) INFORMATION CATEGORIES

VOLUNTEER:

Do they work for free at community events? List what events and how often do they volunteer? What kind of things do they do? Etc.

ABORIGINAL LANGUAGE & CULTURE:

Are they learning, sharing, speaking or knowledgeable of traditional customs & language, such as hunting or food preparation skills. Who did they learn them from? Do they share the traditions and language with others? Etc.

HEALTHY:

Do they refrain from smoking, abusing alcohol and drugs? Eat healthy foods and exercise? What other things do they do to keep healthy? Do they promote healthy living to others? Etc.

HELPFUL:

Do they help others with their work? How do they help others? Do they treat others with respect and care? Etc.

ENTREPRENEUR:

Do they run their own business or co-own a business? What kind of business do they run? How long have they owned their business? Etc.

OVERCOMING ADVERSITY:

Have they overcome various setbacks or challenges? How did they move on with their life in a positive way? How have they overcome their struggles? Etc.

OTHERS:

In what other areas have they impacted you and your community? Have they won awards? How are they a role model? How do they contribute to their community? Etc.

2) LETTER OF SUPPORT

A letter of support must be provided by one of your references. It must include how they know your role model and they agree with this nomination. Explain how the role model is leading their way and is an example for Inuit.
